Ogden House and Gardens Participates in CT Open House Day, June 9

FAIRFIELD (June 6) Ogden House and Gardens, located at 1520 Bronson Road in Fairfield, is participating in the 3rd annual Connecticut Open House Day, on Saturday, June 9. The day is a one-day statewide event designed to pay tribute to Connecticut's unique world of history, art, film and tourism.

Ogden House is listed on the National Register of Historic Places, and is an exceptional survivor of a typical mid-18th century farmhouse., offering a glimpse into the life of a family of the 'middling sort.'" Visitors will view period objects ranging from a 'silver hilted sword,' textiles and fine pieces of furniture with Fairfield provenance, and an eighteenth-century style kitchen garden featuring vegetables and herbs typical of those used at the time.

"We are proud to be participating in this special celebration of Connecticut's rich cultural attractions," said Michael Jehle, Fairfield Historical Society Executive Director.

On June 9, Ogden house will be open for visitors from 1pm – 4pm and will be feature a string quartet, played by members of the Fairfield Ludlowe High School Orchestra. Visitors will also receive information about the other locations participating in the event.

Ogden House and Gardens is managed by the Fairfield Historical Society, which is busy making plans to open the new Fairfield Museum and History Center in September. At the museum's grand opening, the community will be invited to a celebration of historic proportions – be on the lookout for more details this summer.
